



The above diagram illustrates three common use cases of the attributes of element `<style:list-level-label-alignment>` and attribute `fo:text-align`, which are used to specify the position and spacing of a list label and its list item when `text:list-level-position-and-space-mode` attribute has the value `label-alignment`.

The attributes and its values in the first use case are

- `fo:text-align` has value `left`.
- `text:label-followed-by` has value `listtab`.

For the second use case the attributes and its value are

- `fo:text-align` has value `right`.
- `text:label-followed-by` has value `space`.

For the third use case the attributes and its value are

- `fo:text-align` has value `center`.
- `text:label-followed-by` has value `nothing`.

In all use cases the text of the following lines of the paragraph are positioned at the margin which is given by attribute `fo:margin`.
