Dear TC 154 member,

At the last TC meeting on 14th September 2011 in Geneva a New Work Item Proposal (NWIP) on the revision of ISO 9735-10 "EDIFACT – Syntax service directories" was approved. This project was initiated to update the existing standard which was published in 2002. Meanwhile there are 13 services codes updates which should be implemented in ISO 9735-10.

In order to start with the revision project in ISO/TC 154/JWG 1 this call of experts shall ensure to incorporate all interested parties. Even so this call is primarily concentrating on the revision of the standard, it is also to update and increase the membership of JWG 1 in general. Over the last few years this group was responsible for the development and maintenance of the standard series ISO 9735 "Electronic data interchange for administration, commerce and transport (EDIFACT) – Application level syntax rules" including the appropriate maintenance work for the corresponding web site (see www.gefeg.com/jswg).

The experts especially should have knowledge of

- Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) and appropriate implementations in general; and
- UN/EDIFACT incl. the syntax in particular.
