Adoption of ISO/TS 15000-5 "ebCCTS" as an International Standard

Dear TC 154 member,

At the TC meeting on 14th September 2011 in Geneva a New Work Item Proposal (NWIP) on the adoption of ISO/TS 15000-5 "Electronic Business Extensible Markup Language (ebXML) – Part 5: ebXML Core Components Technical Specification, Version 2.01 (ebCCTS)" as International Standard was approved.

This project was initiated to emphasize the importance and international acceptance of this document. Since its publication as Technical Specification in 2005 this document has formed the basis for the establishment and maintenance of the UN/CEFACT Core Component Library (CCL). In addition an Amendment 1:2011 was published to align the ISO/TS with the corresponding UN/CEFACT publication of CCTS, Version 2.01.

In order to start the adoption of this project in ISO/TC 154/WG 3 this call for experts is initiated to ensure participation by all interested parties. Although this call is primarily for the adoption of the ISO/TS as an International Standard, it also includes any necessary update to the TS and the goal of increasing the membership of WG 3. The scope of WG 3 includes revisions of the CCTS document within the framework of ISO.

The nominated experts should have knowledge of

- Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) and appropriate implementations in general;
- The Core Components Technical Specification; and/or
- Use of the Core Components Technical Specification
