

### 1 3.4 MakeConnection Policy Assertion

2 The MakeConnection policy assertion indicates that the MakeConnection protocol (operation and the use  
3 of the MakeConnection URI template in EndpointReferences) is required for messages from this  
4 endpoint.supported. This assertion has Endpoint Policy Subject [WS-PolicyAttachment].

5 The normative outline for the MakeConnection assertion is:

7 The following describes the content model of the MCSupported element.

8 /wsmc:MCSupported

9 A policy assertion that specifies that the MakeConnection protocol is supportedrequired for  
10 instances of messages from this endpoint.

11 /wsmc:MCSupported/{any}

12 This is an extensibility mechanism to allow different (extensible) types of information, based on a  
13 schema, to be passed.

14 /wsmc:MCSupported/@{any}

15 This is an extensibility mechanism to allow additional attributes, based on schemas, to be added to  
16 the element.

17 ~~Because this policy assertion expresses a capability of a receiver (rather than a requirement on the~~  
18 ~~sender), care should be taken to ensure that it is decorated with the appropriate WS-Policy artifacts to~~
