John will draft Roles and Responsibilities. Zulah will draft the Information model/meta model, unless she has to do the Context section. Igor will provide guidance on what was intended to go into the Processing Model and Interaction Patterns section.

    - Zulah noted that we do need to say that the Resource has to have a Web Services manageability, so we are placing some constraints on it. Need to fix up the wording a bit.

    - delegation architecture (was distribution)
  - IV. Implementation Architecture
- 2. Review document outline
  - separate document or not?
    - Do we need to wait for the MUWS Specification document structure?
    - Should probably go ahead and keep it unformatted, just plain text, to allow
    - Then the editors for the MUWS Specification can put what we do into the overall structure.
- 3. Process for editing.
  - Volunteers for document sections – how will we create this document.
    - Zulah volunteered to be the overall editor. People can draft and submit sections to her.
    - Still need Igor and Heather's sections.
    - John volunteered to go into a little more detail about Manager, Manageable Resource, etc. Clear up what requirements there are for capabilities they will need to have. Next level of depth.
    - John will start on the definition of Roles in the Logical section.
    - Zulah will draft the Information meta model/model. Or draft the conceptual model if Heather is otherwise occupied.
    - Processing model and Interactions patterns – not sure what we need besides what comes with Web Services. Need to discuss with Igor.
- There was a side discussion of the overall structure of subgroups meeting. Brought up the issue of OASIS subgroups capability via Web, but consensus of face to face was to mix it all together.
