W3C Processing

AC review of charter has started <http://lists.w3.org/Archives/Member/w3c-ac-members/2006AprJun/0015> - Ending date for review is May 16th

Anticipated timeframe if AC approves and WG has critical mass

Some time after the end date - Call for Participation

Once the call goes out the WG can be formed

An earliest possible telecon could possibly be Wed, May 31

A document (needed) of precise TC proposed spec changes to WG – in the form of editing directions against items to be accomplished with pointers to threads or history – Al Lofton

The W3C process requires that recording of minutes rotates among members and minutes must be out in a short period (24-48 hours).

Minutes must be in txt or html formats – suggestion that all members go to W3C and download the Amaya editor

We are awaiting response from Chris on meaning of block and inline.
Dieter commented that we should not specify any search mechanism. We should state that the content attribute of para should contain full para content and the content attribute of subpara should contain full subpara content. Admit that the content attribute underspecified, but we cannot define a search mechanism for 2.0.

Lofton agreed that this is a good approach

Dieter reiterated that search is out of scope for 2.0 and will be addressed in future.

Lofton will prepare a complete list of proposed changes taking Dieter's approach.
