

Proposal for new KMIP TC rule

In order to ensure that changes to the KMIP Specification are accompanied in a timely fashion by corresponding changes (if any) to the KMIP Usage Guide, the KMIP TC chairs propose the following new rule for the KMIP TC:

No motion for any addition, deletion or modification to the KMIP Specification shall be accepted unless any KMIP Usage Guide addition, deletion or modification required in support of the change to the KMIP Specification has been defined and included in the same or an accompanying ballot.

This rule has been reviewed by OASIS and no issues have been identified (see email below).
