OASIS Bylaws Changes

Bylaws Change: TC Charter “Vitality”

- Section 1.10 TC Vitality of the TC Process (<https://www.oasis-open.org/policies-guidelines/tc-process-2017-05-26/#tcVitality>) states:
 - "... every 4 years from the date of the first meeting of the TC or the first meeting after a recharter, the TC must decide one on the following actions by Full Majority vote:
 - Continue the TC with its current charter;
 - Continue the TC through a charter clarification (Section 1.8);
 - Recharter the TC (Section 1.9); or
 - Close the TC."
- The purpose of section 1.10 is to "ensure the TC charter continues to align with the activities of the TC."
- Basically, it is an effort to encourage TCs to periodically consider whether the charter still reflects the work actually being done.

Bylaws Change: TC Charter “Vitality”

Proposed approach for discussion:

1. Take existing TC charter and make minor revisions to bring up to date (e.g. remove references to CybOX.)
 - a. Make draft available to TC members for review/comment/discussion.
 - b. Open ballot for approval of “clarified” charter no later than the February TC meeting.
2. Once the STIX/TAXII 2.1 specs are full OASIS standards (hopefully by early Summer), the TC may consider whether a rechartering of the TC is warranted/desirable and proceed accordingly.

Bylaws Change: TC Chair(s) Reappointment

- Sect. 1.4 Chairs of the OASIS Committee Operations Process (<https://www.oasis-open.org/policies-guidelines/oasis-committee-operations-process/#chairs>) states:
 - "Every two years a Committee must re-appoint its chair(s)."
 - The purpose of the new addition to section 1.4 is to allow committees to reconfirm the desire of the existing Chair(s) to continue in their role or to provide a graceful way for them to step back and allow other members to take on the role.
- To reappoint the Chair(s), OASIS suggests the following steps:
 - Notify the committee of the requirement and issue a call for candidates to the committee's primary mailing list. Note that the current chairs are welcome to indicate their willingness to continue. In the email, indicate whether the committee will handle the election in a meeting or via a ballot. Provide 7 days for members to propose themselves or other members as candidates.
 - If you have one or two candidates, you can handle the reelection via a call for objections.

Bylaws Change: TC Chair(s) Reappointment

Proposed way forward for discussion:

1. Trey Darley and Rich Struse are willing to continue to serve for the time being *if the TC wishes*.
 - a. Regardless, Rich intends to step down as TC co-chair once the 2.1 specifications have been ratified as full OASIS standards.
 - b. Trey has indicated that he is willing to remain as co-chair for some time after Rich steps down to provide continuity in TC leadership.
2. We will send a notice to the TC mailing list about the OASIS bylaws change and asking for any nominations.
3. If no nominations are received, we will proceed with a call for objections to continuing with the current TC leadership for the time being.
4. If nominations are received, we will open a ballot to select the TC co-chairs.

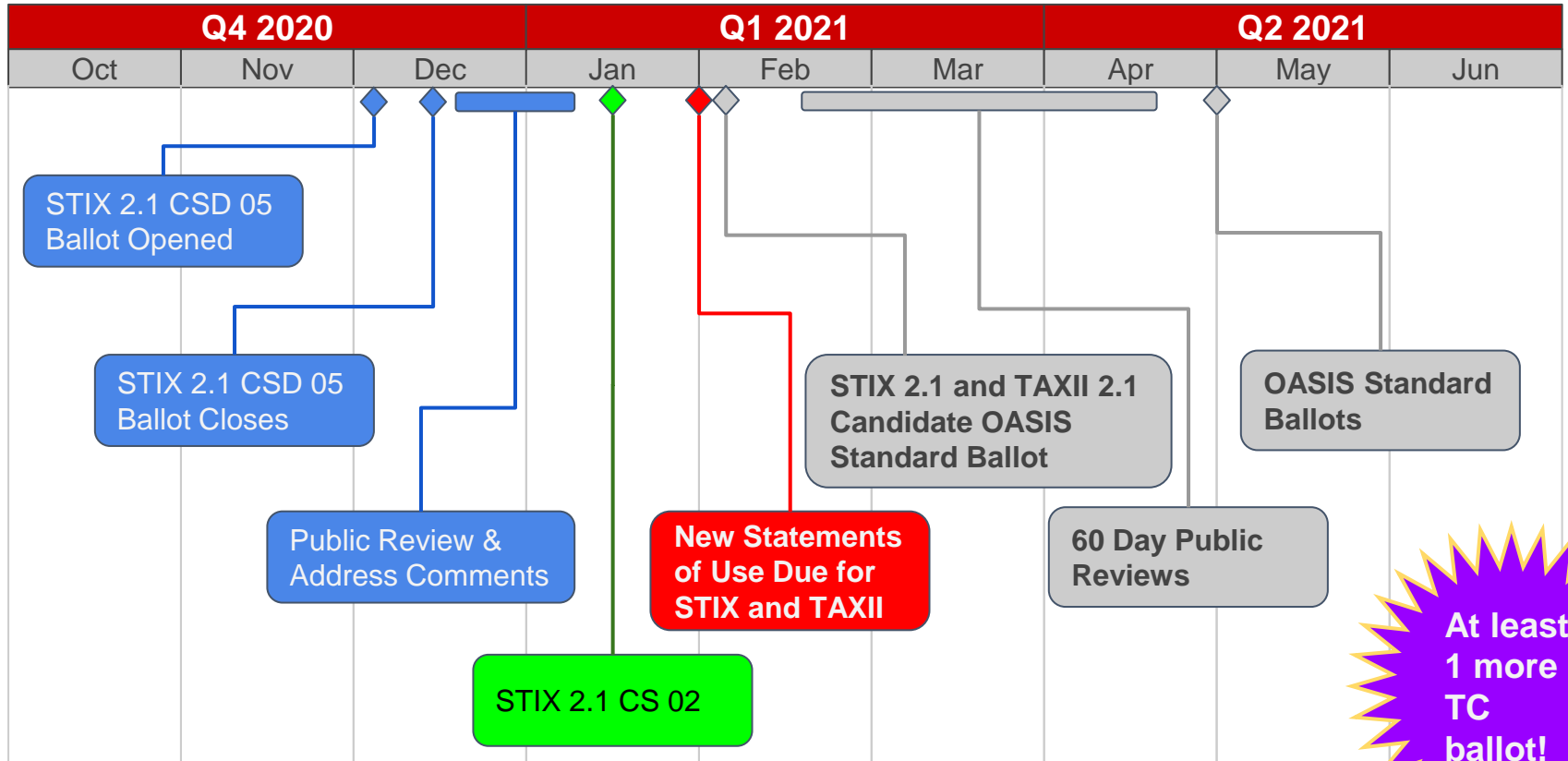
STIX and TAXII Roadmap

Statements of Use

1. Needs to reference the approved specification
2. Needs to come from your primary representative to OASIS or they need to acknowledge it.
 - a. The best way is to have your primary rep send an email to the member stating they confirm the SoU and then the member can append that to the SoU and send it to the email list themselves.
 - b. Or the primary representative can send it to Chet the OASIS Admin

<ACME Cyber> has successfully implemented STIX Version 2.1 Committee Specification 02, approved 25 January 2021 and TAXII Version 2.1 Committee Specification 01, approved 27 January 2020, in accordance with the conformance clauses defined in Section 12 and Section 8, respectively.
