



# The first regulatory problem

To move telecommunication equipment into the requesting state without delays or costs




# My recommendations

## States

- Sign the Convention
- Consider to allow free circulation of equipment
- If not, consider temporary free movement when the Tampere Convention is used


## Assisting Parties

- Check that your assistance has been requested
- Make sure you know how to reach responsible organisation in case of problems



# The second regulatory problem


To be allowed to use the telecommunication equipment



# My recommendations

## States


- If type approval is used consider to change to suppliers declaration
- Reconsider if licensing is required for anything else than radio transmitters
- Exempt radio transmitters not liable to cause interference from licensing
- If above cannot be achieved consider temporary waiver when the Tampere Convention is used
- Be prepared to make temporary changes in the frequency plan based on new priorities and requests from assisting entities. National or local. Rather within hours than days. Scenario preparations.



# My recommendations (continuation)

## Assisting Parties

- Establish direct contact early with responsible organisation
- Forward list of equipment - most important radio transmitters – and needs for radio spectrum



# The third problem is more a way to facilitate solving the two regulatory problems

## My recommendations

- State Parties shall notify remaining regulatory barriers and contact points of responsible organisations
- Potential assisting parties to send information about telecommunication equipment planned to be used, especially on radio transmitters and needs for radio spectrum
- The operational coordinator should keep updated information available to all parties for their preparation
