**Specification Overview:**

This is an Errata for CMIS 1.0. It contains a list of nonsubstantive changes to the CMIS 1.0 specification.

**TC Description:**

The CMIS TC develops interoperable interfaces for content management repositories/systems, and conducts interoperability testing among TC member implementations.

**Public Review Period:**

The public review starts Monday, 10 October 2011 and ends Tuesday, 25 October 2011. The specification was previously submitted for a 15-day public review on 8 June 2011 [2].

This is an open invitation to comment. OASIS solicits feedback from potential users, developers and others, whether OASIS members or not, for the sake of improving the interoperability and quality of its technical work.
