

Classification of Everyday Living V1.0 (#COEL) becomes an OASIS Standard

OASIS is pleased to announce that Classification of Everyday Living Version 1.0 has been approved by the membership as an OASIS Standard [1].

The ballot was held under the OASIS call for consent procedure [2]. Under this procedure, consent is assumed unless eligible voters register valid objections. In the ballot, Classification of Everyday Living V1.0 received 12 affirmative consents and no objections. Therefore the standard is approved.

Digital technologies are becoming integral to our daily lives. They promise huge benefits to society, but the data they create carries the potential for abuse.

COEL is a hierarchical taxonomy of everyday human life events. It provides a privacy-by-design framework for collecting and processing behavioral data that is uniquely suited to the transparent use of dynamic data for personalized digital services, IoT applications where devices are collecting information about identifiable individuals, and the coding of behavioral data in identity solutions.

COEL aims to be a roadmap for collecting and handling personal data that protects the interests of both individuals and businesses.
